Policy Statement

What information we collect

We collect details on our supporters:

- To give the opportunity to stay involved as a valued supporter.
- We use systems that we store data safely in the cloud.

We collect details on our staff:

• To keep records on our staff to honour our obligations as employers.

Sharing information

We will not give any information we hold to anyone outside The Bumblebee
Children's Charity, without express consent, unless it is lawful, and our policies and procedures allow us to do so.



 We will share information in accordance with our Information sharing and data protection policy and procedures.

Security of information

The Bumblebee Children's Charity is committed to ensuring the security of all personal information. We have in place appropriate physical, electronic and general data protection procedures to secure the information we collect on families and supporters.

All 3rd party providers used for the administration of The Bumblebee Children's Charity work are carefully vetted and every precaution made to protect identity and any personal information.

We will retain all information for a reasonable period or as long as the law requires. We will regularly review our data collection and information sharing procedures (at least annually) to ensure we are complaint with General Data Protection Regulations. Any breach, or near miss, of any information will be logged and appropriate action taken to inform the Information Commissioner's Office if required.
